JET STREAM is a new journal of weather data published bi-monthly from March 1981. JET STREAM brings you an immediate report and analysis of the weather around the world, and provides convenient summary of global data for permanent reference. It is designed to appeal to meteorologists, engineers, economists, teachers, farmers and anyone with an interest in weather and climate. Technical language will be kept to a minimum, and there will be short articles to explain unfamiliar concepts.

JET STREAM contains a summary of the weather of the preceding months over as many parts of the world as possible, including descriptions of notable events and anomalies, explanations of them in terms of atmospheric circulation patterns, and information about sea temperatures, snow and ice. It also includes, tables of monthly mean temperature and rainfall for many stations, and maps of circulation anomalies for both hemispheres. A feature of special interest is a series of articles on the principles and problems of long-range forecasting. JET STREAM is edited by Peter B. Wright.
