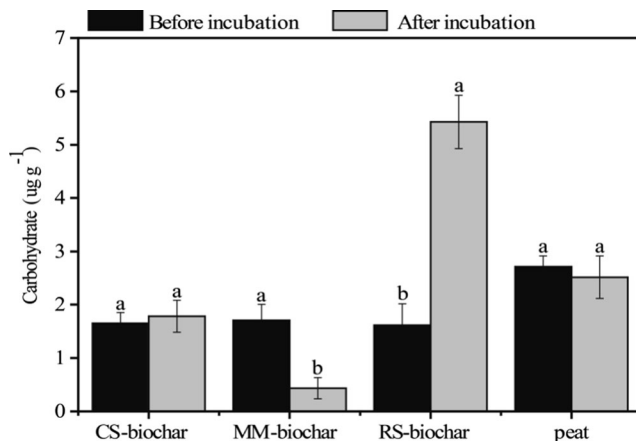
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In the published version of this article, there was an error in Fig. 2.
