As standard, the level of recommendation according to the Scottish Intercollegiate Guideline Network (SIGN 2008) is reported alphabetically (A/B/C/D/Good practice points) and the level of evidence is reported numerically (1++/1+/1-/2++/2+/2-/3/4). In this guideline article some of the levels of evidence were mistakenly assigned letters rather than numbers:

- A instead of the correct 1+
- B instead of the correct 2++
- C instead of the correct 2+
- D instead of the correct 3

The article has now been corrected.
