Many readers have asked when the *Annals of Behavioral Medicine* will be available electronically. The answer is that the *Annals* is available on the Internet, and it has been for several years. Many universities subscribe to the electronic version of *Annals*. Further, all Society of Behavioral Medicine (SBM) members have an electronic subscription and can get access to *Annals* electronically.

To access the electronic version of *Annals*, simply go to the Lawrence Erlbaum Associates Web site at <http://www.erlbaum.com>. Once the page is loaded, you will see a series of boxes on the left side of the screen. Click on "Journals." This will bring up a screen that offers several choices. It is easiest to select "Journals Alphabetically by Title." Then you will see the long impressive list of journals published by Lawrence Erlbaum Associates. The second journal of the list is *Annals of Behavioral Medicine*. By clicking on the *Annals* hypertext, you arrive at the *Annals* page, which describes the journal and lists the Editor and Associate Editors. Above the Editorial Scope is a box that says "Online Access & TOC Alerting Service." By clicking on this button, you will be given a list of volumes and issue numbers.

By clicking on a particular issue, you will get the Table of Contents for that issue. For example, if you click on Number 3

for Volume 25, you will see the Table of Contents for that issue. Suppose that you would like to look at the article by Shari Waldstein and Halina Burns. To get that article, you would click on the page number to the right of that entry on the Table of Contents. In this case, it is page 163. That will bring up the abstract of the article and information about the authors. If you scroll down to the bottom of the page, you are given a chance to log into the system. The user name for all SBM members is abm01. You can obtain the password from the Society of Behavioral Medicine if you are a member. Once you enter this information, you can get a full text copy of the article. At the bottom of the page you will be given format options. These include Real Page, PDF (full document), and PDF (page at a time). I prefer PDF full document. If you select this option and then select "Request Document," you should obtain a PDF copy of the article that provides a perfect reprint.

We are pleased to offer the electronic version of *Annals* to all SBM members. For readers who are not SBM members, we do hope that your institution libraries subscribe to the electronic version. These new electronic advances help *Annals* reach its goal for improved dissemination of our work.
